## ***Remedial Language/Math Instructor (Orton-Gillingham)***

At LDAH our mission is to provide leadership in Learning Disabilities' advocacy, education and services, and to advance the full participation of children, youth and adults with Learning Disabilities in today's society.

We are seeking a qualified individual to join our non-profit organization, based in our Burlington Resource Centre.

### **Job Description:**

The Remedial Language/Math Instructor supports the Learning Disabilities Association of Halton's (LDAH) Instructional Remediation Orton-Gillingham Tutoring program: A one-on-one tutoring program primarily targeted towards children that have a Learning Disability who are experiencing difficulty in reading, writing and spelling and/or basic arithmetic. The program utilizes the multi-sensory Orton-Gillingham instructional approach.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Perform pre and post assessments of each student to determine individual needs and progress in the program.
- Maintain daily written lesson plans and evaluations of each student throughout the program.
- Maintain effective and ongoing communication with the Executive Director and President of the LDAH in respect to program related matters.
- Maintain ongoing communication with parents on matters such as: child's progress in the program, what has been covered during the program and what the goals are for the student, encouraging parents to implement assigned program homework at home, and any other support for parents related to their child's learning.
- Supervise students at all times, including during breaks.
- Ensure that all student information and teaching materials are returned to the staff or board designate at the end of each yearly session or on the departure of a student.
- Complete a report for each student at the end of the yearly program session or when he/she exits the program.

- Participate in a program summary session at the end of each program year.

**Qualifications:**

- Must be an Associate level or Certified level member of the Academy of Orton-Gillingham Practitioners and Educators.
- Must have prior experience in providing one-on-one tutoring in reading, writing and/or math for children that have a learning disability or related learning difficulty, utilizing the Orton-Gillingham or equivalent multi-sensory approach.
- Must have sound understanding of a learning disability and the characteristics that accompany a learning disability.
- Certification with the Ontario College of Teachers is an asset, but not mandatory.

**Location:** LDAH Resource Centre - 560 Guelph Line, Burlington, Ontario L7R 3M4

**Time Commitment:**

- The tutoring program begins at the beginning of September once the school year has commenced, and concludes at the end of May. The official end date is subject to any make up classes that are owed to students.
- Hours are part-time and average 18-20 per week including afternoons, evenings and weekends.
- Participation is also required during a 2-week Language Booster Boot Camp that takes place in the summer, which utilizes the same program.
- Expected to work one-on-one with a student, twice per week for one hour tutoring sessions, depending on the availability of the student.
- Number of hours cannot be guaranteed and will depend on the number of students requiring support.
- No classes will be scheduled on Statutory Holidays or school breaks.
