

INSTRUCTIONAL REMEDIATION

The Learning Disabilities Association of Halton offers a remediation tutoring program in reading,/writing and mathematics for children that have Learning Disabilities and/or Attention Deficit Disorder who require intensive, one-on-one support

About the Program:

Specialized for children with **Learning Disabilities and/or ADHD** (diagnosis not required)

Classes are **one-on-one, and take place twice per week for one hour from September - May** (if space permits, students may join later in the year).

Based on the **research-based Orton-Gillingham Approach, which is language-based, multi-sensory, structured, sequential, cumulative, cognitive, and flexible.**

A **safe and comfortable learning environment** with a **qualified teacher/tutor**

Each child is pre tested to determine their needs , and teacher designs daily lesson plans which focus on the required skills. All children **move at their own pace**, and daily practice homework is required to gain the maximum benefit from the program

●● Program Focus

Reading/Writing

-phonological awareness, sound/symbol association, vocabulary development, reading comprehension, fluency, blending/decoding, handwriting, basic grammar (including parts of speech), spelling, sentence/paragraph structure, punctuation

OR

Mathematics

- basic skills in computation, measurement, fractions, use of money, telling time

Members fee: \$59.50/hour
Non-Members fee: \$64.50/hour

***** Monthly payment plans arranged with provided post-dated cheques*****

Annual Membership costs \$50 for Family/Individual. Membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the teaching year. Renewal may be required.

PLEASE NOTE: Parents must share their child's psycho-educational assessment as well as any other pertinent information such as assessments by either a speech and language pathologist or an occupational therapist. All assessments are reviewed by the teacher. While the child is attending the program, assessments are secured in a locked filing cabinet and returned on leaving the program.
