- Work with a pair of children that require literacy support for 8 weeks, twice per week for 1 hour (16 nights in total), implementing a literacy program to meet each child's individual needs
- Utilize hands-on literacy activities and games to teach and reinforce the components of the program
- Create a unique and creative work station poster board with the children where successes are graphed and celebrated
- Conduct informal literacy assessments on the first and last night of the program
- Provide a positive learning environment to invoke motivation and confidence in the children
